*Passports, the library's integrated research system, provides "main-campus" library resources and services to Webster students and faculty worldwide.*

### RESOURCES INCLUDE:

<b>125+ Subscription Databases</b>	includes 80+ full-text databases with selected full-text articles & reference material
<b>Electronic Books</b>	15,000 titles online through the <i>netLibrary</i> database , and other e-books through the Library catalog
<b>Full-Text Sources</b>	over 25,000 full-text sources including journals, newspapers, reference sources & other documents covering all subject fields
<b>(Full-text) PsycBooks (American Psychological Association)</b>	A database of more than 10,000 chapters in PDF from over 800 books published by APA and other distinguished publishers. The database includes most scholarly titles published by APA from copyright years 1953 - 2004.
<b>Full-text Reference Works</b>	includes the 32 volume Encyclopedia Britannica online, Gale Virtual Library (over 59 titles), Literature Resource Center, subject specific encyclopedias and composites from hundreds of directories, and factual sources
<b>Full-text News and Legal Information</b>	includes 5,900 sources from <i>LEXIS-NEXIS Academic</i> .
<b>Statistical Compendiums</b>	includes the <i>Bureau of Economic Analysis Information</i> , <i>National Trade Data Bank</i> , <i>Stat-USA</i> and <i>WiserTrade</i> .
<b>Investment reports and financial data</b>	over <b>47,000</b> U.S. and international companies from <i>Investext Plus</i> , <i>Valueline Investment Survey and Mergent</i>
<b>Indexing and abstracting</b>	over <b>70,000</b> journals
<b>Library Holdings records</b>	bibliographic records for over <b>67 million</b> items in over 54,000 libraries worldwide
