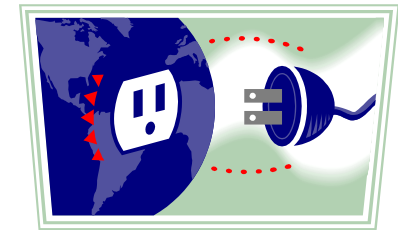

Emerson Library offers a wealth of resources and special services to students, faculty & staff to support your academic research and teaching. **Passports**, the website for the Webster U Library, is the online gateway to these resources and services.

LIBRARY CATALOG: The catalog lists almost 370,000 items including 1,200 current periodical subscriptions and over 12,000 video/DVDs, owned by the library. Click on [New Titles](#) under "What's New" on Passports to view a monthly list. Use our **Document Delivery** service to have books delivered directly to your home or office.

ELECTRONIC BOOKS: The library offers more than 19,000 current and classic **e-books** covering a variety of subjects. eBooks are hot linked from the library catalog and can also be searched in the *netLibrary*, *Gale Virtual Reference Library*, or the *PsycBooks* database.

VIDEO COLLECTION: The library offers educational videos and DVDs on many topics. Use the library catalog or the [Video/DVDs](#) link to search by title, keyword, genre or language. Faculty are advised to reserve videos early for use in the classroom.

ONLINE SERVICES

ARTICLE LINKER links an article citation in one Passports database to the full-text of the article, if available, in another.

The [JOURNAL MAGAZINE NEWSPAPER A-Z LIST](#) allows one to search by periodical title for the more than 23,000 titles available in print in the library or full-text in one of the library's article databases. Click on [Articles/Databases](#) to access the list.

DOCUMENT DELIVERY: Webster patrons worldwide may request library materials. **For articles**, first check the [Journal Magazine Newspaper List](#) to see if we subscribe to the periodical or have it online. We post articles from our periodicals in 2 business days. If you wish us to request articles from another library, allow 7 days. **For books**, first check the catalog to make certain Emerson owns it. Allow at least 7 business days for UPS delivery.

ELECTRONIC RESERVES:

E-Reserves allow faculty to post electronic documents and web links for their classes on a secure server. To access E-Reserves, or set up & administer an account, see <http://ereserves.webster.edu/eres>

- *RefWorks*, a bibliographic citation manager, allows one to import or enter citations into a personal database and export them in a variety of citation styles including APA, MLA, etc.

- *Central Search* provides a single simple interface which searches multiple Passports databases and the library catalog, simultaneously.
