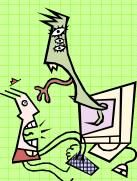

Document Delivery: The Magic Revealed

Marian replies:

You're welcome! To receive great document delivery (DocDel) service, currently registered students at extended campuses and in online programs should:

First check the **Journal/Magazine/Newspaper A-Z List** (linked from [Articles/Databases](#) page), or **Article Linker** from within a Passports database, to see if the article you seek is available **a)** online in a database or **b)** in the library as a print subscription or **c)** neither

Note: If you have trouble linking to the **Article** in a database, please call us.

To request an article using Document Delivery

- ✦ If the article is not available online (**c**) OR the library has it only in print (**b**), fill out a DocDel request form for **each** article. The form is linked from **Article Linker** and under **How do I ... Request books or articles** on Passports. Please remember, the more complete your citation, the faster our staff can find and fill your request.
- ✦ We can supply articles from our print periodicals in 2 business days and we can get articles for you from other libraries in about 5 business days!
- ✦ To get your article from another library, DocDel staff identify at least five lending libraries that could potentially supply it. An electronic request is sent to each in turn until a library can fill it. Someone at that lending library pulls the journal from the shelf and scans or copies the article.
- ✦ Scanned copies are sent to Emerson electronically (fast!) but print copies are sent by fax (slow) or US mail (really slow!).
- ✦ If necessary, DocDel staff scan printed articles into Adobe PDF. Then we post the electronic copy to a secure area of our website and **email*** you instructions to retrieve it from any Internet-accessible computer.



***BTW**, if you're watching your email to see if your article has arrived, keep an eye on your junk email folder. Our DocDel software automatically generates notification messages and some email clients regularly identify such email as spam!
