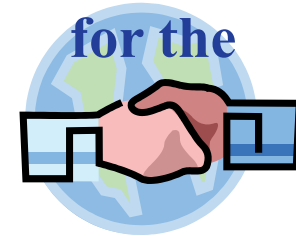

Liaison Services

Each librarian is assigned to one or more academic departments. As the liaison for the Department of Music, I work to:

- Build a quality library collection in print and electronic formats to support faculty teaching and student learning
- Integrate library instruction and services into music courses at Webster home and extended campuses
- Find information for teaching or personal research projects
- Answer questions or concerns about the library



Ordering New Materials

Each year, the Library allocates a percentage of the library's budget to be used by the Music Department to purchase books, scores, ebooks, DVDs, sound recordings and other media to support teaching and learning.

The Library's website links to a monthly [New Titles List](#), which shows newly acquired materials.

CMS Library Collection Update

Integration of the music books, scores, and CDs from CMS is virtually complete. These total about 1,000 books, 15,000 scores, and 1,000 CDs, as well as the 900-piece Risch Collection of bassoon and woodwind scores. When the last of these are processed and bound, access and shelving locations will be consistent with the rest of the library's collection. During this final transition, please contact Allen if you have any difficulty locating music materials.

Other Library Music Materials

A significant collection in Emerson Library's music holdings is the Dial Organ Collection, consisting of some 2,500 scores of organ music.

Music scores and books are located on the south end of the 3rd floor. Videos and sound recordings are shelved on the main level.

Scores and books not in our collection can often be borrowed through MOBIUS or Inter-library Loan.

Professional & Trade Periodicals

The library subscribes to about 25,000 periodical titles in print and/or electronically through our databases. You may browse or search the [Journal Magazine Newspaper A-Z List](#) to see if a journal is available in the library or online.
